


## AxiomV™ Language Utility

1. Start the utility by running Language.exe.




The opening screen shows the list of languages in English. You can change the font used in this utility by clicking the *Font* button (this will not affect Axiom's font).

2. Select the language to be translated.



The screen will split with English on the left (in grey) and the language being translated on the right (in white).


**3.** Choose the grouping to be translated.



Languages are shown initially and are simply the list of available languages an operator can choose from. System Messages are the messages that appear on the Event Monitor (e.g. Input Alarm or Access Granted). Words are the captions, words, phrases, instructions, etc. that are used in the program.

Click *Edit* to enter or exit the edit mode. All changes made while in the edit mode can immediately be seen in the program, with the exception of the menus. To see the changes in the menus switch to another language (in the operator's properties) and then switch it back again.

**4.** Fill in a translation for every entry under English. Items that have not been translated can cause confusion in the future.
