


Axiom Data Receiver - ADR

What is ADR?

Axiom Data Receiver or ADR is an add on module to the AxiomV platform that allows third party software to send user authenticated data to AxiomV which in turn grants access to access points.... Virtual Credentials!

How does ADR Work?

The ADR module listens for any incoming messages and converts them to a standard credential format. ADR then passes the message to the required Access point where the standard verification process in the Reader control panel is followed and access is granted or denied by applying the access levels. The Virtual Credentials are programmed into AxiomV just like any other standard credential.



What are the Benefits of ADR?

Virtual Credentials

ADR means AxiomV can be set up with no credentials which is ideal for gym members, places of worship and parking facilities.

Multiple Format Streams

ADR is configurable to match any third parties protocol.
